

Being mindful of screen-time, attention-grabbing mechanisms and other possible threats.

How can we use them safely?
Is it important to be mindful of the amount of time we spend online or using a screen, even if it is for a positive reason?

ONLINE/GAMING AGREEMENT

Owning a smart phone opens our children to a world of exposure to both good and bad. It is important that we as their caregivers place boundaries and open channels of communication. This challenge for parents is to review the boundries we have in place to protect them.

Do you have set rules in relation to interpet/screen use in your house?

We ask you to review these with your children and see if they need updating or if you do not have any, take this oportunity to put some in place.



- Is there a time limit on screen time?
- Are phones allowed in the bedroom over night?
- Is dinner time phone free?
- Homework before phone time?
- Do you know your child's passcode?
- Can you check their phone?

KEEP YOUR ACCOUNTS ON PRIVATE AND YOUR LOCATION SETTINGS OFF UNLESS IT IS ESSENTIAL - YOU CAN SET GOOGLE MAPS TO ONLY TRACK YOUR LOCATION WHEN YOU USE THE APP AND MAKE SURE THINGS LIKE YOUR SNAPMAP ARE ON PRIVATE! SHARE YOUR LOCATION TO PARENTS DIRECTLY WHEN NEEDED VIA WHATSAPP INSTEAD.
